NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following ordinance was adopted by the Jerome Town Council on **October 11, 2016**:

ORDINANCE NO. 421

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, RESCINDING SECTION 10-1-1, "BEES," OF THE JEROME TOWN CODE IN ORDER TO REMOVE THE PROHIBITION ON BEEKEEPING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 10-1-1, "Bees," of the Jerome Town Code, is hereby rescinded as follows, and the section number marked as "Reserved":

Section 10-1-1 ~~Bees~~ (RESERVED)

~~It is unlawful for any persons to place bee hives and to have live bees for the purpose of obtaining honey therefrom within the corporate limits of the Town.~~

Section 2. Following its adoption, this Ordinance shall be published by the Town Clerk in accordance with the requirements of A.R.S. § 39-203 *et seq.*

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency herewith.
