

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 103

RELATING TO MOVING PICTURE THEATERS.

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Every room in which a moving picture exhibition or entertainment is conducted and which has a seating capacity of not more than three hundred persons, shall have at least one passageway or aisle not less than four feet in width. Every room which has a seating capacity of over three hundred persons shall have at least two passageways or aisles at least four feet in width, which shall open directly into a public street or alley, said exits may open into a passageway along the sides of such room, having at least two doors of standard size entering such passageway, which doors shall not be locked or fastened during any performance, and said passageway shall be at least four feet in width.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined in any sum of not less than \$25 nor more than \$200, and be imprisoned in the Town jail not less than 10 days nor more than 90 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
