

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 104

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION NINE OF ORDINANCE THIRTY NINE AND ORDINANCE ONE HUNDRED. ENTITLED "PROVIDING FOR REVENUE AND THE COLLECTION THEREOF", and, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance numbered one hundred be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary and requires an immediate enactment, to preserve the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication and the same is hereby exempted from the operation of the referendum provisions of the Constitution and Statates of the State of Arizona .
