

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 112

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person firm or corporation to leave or park any automobile or other vehicle in front of or within ten feet of any hydrant which is used for fire protection.

Section 2. Any person who shall in any manner willfully injure, deface or mar any hose wagon, hose, hook, ladder, rope, bucket, uniform or any property of any sort whatever belonging to or used by the Fire Department of the Town of Jerome shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 3. Any person who in any manner who wilfully obstructs, injures or interferes with any well, pump, ditch, pipe, hydrant, plug or any other means of water supply of the Town of Jerome or who obstructs, injures or interferes in any manner with the use of the same is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Any person who violates any of the preceeding sections shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, and by imprisonment in the Town jail for not less than five days nor more than thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
