TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 115

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROMF DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Every fortune teller, palmist, clairoyant, seer, astrologer, shall include all persons who shall or may, by sign or advertisement, or notice of any kind, purport to pursue any of these occupations, or practising or carrying on any of the occult sciences, shall pay a license tax of \$1,250.00 per quarter, payable in advance.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Any person who practices or attemts to practice any of the above named methods of fortune telling as prescribed in section one, without having procured the required license, shall upon conviction, be fined in any sum of not more than three hundred dollars nor less than one hundred dollars, or be imprisoned in the town jail for not less than ten days nor more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

WHEREAS, the public welfare demands that this ordinance be made to operate from and after its passage and approval, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance is hereby made exempt of the teferendum provisions as prescribed by the Constitution and laws of the State of Ariaonz.
