

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 119

RELATING TO THE PARKING OF MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES
THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Hereafter, it shall be unlawful for any automobile, automobile truck, or other vehicle, to park between sundown and sunrise, or for more than one hour during the day time, and at no time upon or within five feet of any turn or curve upon the following named streets or avenues.

That part of Main street adjacent to the T.F. Miller Co. Building.

Clark street, from the Schrum Building to the City limits along the Prescott highway.

First street, between Main street and Hull Avenue.

School street, from the intersection of Main and School streets to fifth street via the Methodist Church.

Verde Avenue.

The County Road, from the Primary School Building to the City limits, including the upper and lower Hogback roads.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined in any sum of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$300.00 or imprisonment on the Town Jail for not less than 5 days nor more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

WHEREAS, as this ordinance is necessary and requires immediate operation to preserve the public safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Jerome, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication and posting, and the same is hereby exempted from the provisions of the referendum as provided for by the Constitution and laws of Arizona.
