

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 125

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 106 AND FIXING THE AGE LIMIT OF MINORS AT 21.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any owner, manager or person in charge of any public room, place or structure, within the corporate limits of Jerome, to permit any minor under 21 Years of age to engage or play or practice any game of billiard or pool or any game of dice, cards or other game of chance or skill, either for amusement or thing of representative value.

Section 2. Any minor under the age of 21 years who shall play any of the games or frequent the places mentioned in the preceding section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Any person who shall violate either of the preceding sections shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) or more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), or be imprisoned in the Town jail for not less than five (5) days or more than thirty (30) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
