TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 131

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY*ONE BY ADDING TO SECTION ONE THEREOF, SECTION ONE A, ENTITLED, "PROVIDING FOR THE PASTEURIZATION OF MILK."

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That section one of Ordinance 121, be and the same is hereby amended, by adding thereto a section to be known as Section 1-A, which shall read as follows:

Section 1-A. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell or offer for sale or exchange or expose for sale for human consumption, in the Town of Jerome, Arizona, except in bulk to pasteurizing plants accepted and approved by the Health Officer of the Town of Jerome, any milk or milk products until the same have been pasteurized by heating to a *emperature of approximately 1½5 degrees Fahrenheit, never less than 1½2 degrees Fahrenheit, and holding at said temperature for a period of not less than thirty minutes, and then cooling immediately to a temperature not to exceed 50 degrees Farenheit.

Every plant used or operated for pasteurizing milk as hereinbefore provided shall be kept and maintained in a thoroughly clean and sanitary manner and shall be screened and equipped with a recording thermometer and temperature chart for the pasteurizer, all to be approved before operation by the Health Officer of the Town of Jerome, which approval may be withdrawn at any time by the Health Officer for the failure to maintain said plant strictly in accordance with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding the sum of three hundred (\$300.00) dollars, or by imprisonment in the Town Jail for a period of not exceeding ninety (90) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. Al ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section μ_{\bullet} . This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
