## TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 132

RELATING TO BUILDINGS AND THE CARRYING ON OF CERTAIN BUSINESSES INSIDE THE FIRE LIMITS OF JEROME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, YAVA-PAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 8 of Ordinance No. 128 is hereby ammended to read as follows, by adding thereto the following paragraph to be known as Section 8A:

No wood yard shall be maintained hereafter in Fire Districts 1, 2, or 3 of the Town of Jerome, as the same now are or may hereafter be fixed, except by special permit so to do from the Town of Jerome.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of the foregoing ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by fine of not less than ten ( $^{\circ}$ 10.00) dollars, nor more than three hundred ( $^{\circ}$ 300.00) dollars, or by imprisonment in the Town Jail for a period of not more than three (3) months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section h. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary and requires an early operation to preserve the public health and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Jerome, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, and the same is hereby exempted from the referendum provisions of the Constitution and laws of the State of Arizona.
