

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 135

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING EMPLOYMENT AGENTS WITHIN THE TOWN OF JEROME TO OBTAIN A PERMIT AND PAY A LICENSE TAX BEFORE TRANSACTING ANY BUSINESS AS AN EMPLOYMENT AGENT, EXCEPT WHEN THE LABOR EMPLOYED IS TO BE USED BY THE PERSON OPERATING OR CONDUCTING SUCH EMPLOYMENT AGENCY AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.

Section 1. Every person, firm, or corporation, before transacting, engaging in or carrying on any of the business of an employment agent or agency within the the Town of Jerome, must first apply for, and obtain a permit therefor from the Town Clerk; provided, however, that such permit shall not be required in any case where the labor employed is used wholly by the person, firm or corporation who or which operates, carries on or conducts any such employment agency, and any such person, firm or corporation shall not be deemed an employment agent within the meaning of this ordinance.

Section 2. Every person, firm or corporation of whom a permit is required, as provided in Section 1, shall in addition to obtaining such permit, pay a quarterly license tax of twenty-five ("25.00) dollars.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation of whom a permit is required, as in this Ordinance provided, who shall transact any business as an employment agent without first obtaining said permit, or who shall fail to pay said license tax, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred (\$300.00) dollars, or by imprisonment for not more than three months in the Town Jail, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Whereas, the immediate preservation of the safety and welfare of the town requires that this ordinance shall take effect at once, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be effective, and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
