

ORDINANCE NO. 141.

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 123 regulating the carrying on of certain professions, trades, callings and occupations within the Town of Jerome, prescribing license fees therefor providing for the collection of licenses and providing for the punishment for violation of said Ordinance.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Jerome:

Section 1. That Article 1 of Section 11 of said Ordinance 123 be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Article 1. For real estate agents, house brokers and insurance agents, five dollars (\$5.00) per quarter.

That article 2 of said section be amended as follows:

Article 2. For keepers of hotels, apartment houses, rooming houses and all other places where room or lodging is furnished, the rates shall be governed by the number of rooms in said hotel, rooming house and lodging house, and it shall be immaterial whether or not said rooms are occupied by guests or by the operator or his family.

From 4 to 12 rooms - three dollars (\$3.00) per quarter.

From 12 to 24 rooms - six dollars (\$6.00) per quarter.

From 24 to 40 rooms - seven and 50/100 (\$7.50) per quarter.

Over 40 rooms - ten dollars (\$10.00) per quarter.

For keepers of restaurants six dollars (\$6.00) per quarter.

For keepers of boarding houses three dollars (\$3.00)

per quarter.

PROVIDED, that no license shall be collected from any private boarding house or any private lodging house except that either boarding or lodging shall be furnished to at least four (4) persons by said private boarding or lodging house.

That Article 8 of said Section be amended as follows:

Article 8. For keepers or owners of laundries or any place where washing or ironing is carried on for the public and not less than six (6) persons are employed in the operation thereof, ten dollars (\$10.00) per quarter, all others fifteen (\$15.00) per quarter.

That Article 10 of said Section be amended as follows:

Article 10. Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of buying or selling mining stock, bonds, state, county or city bonds, or stocks of incorporated companies, or evidence of indebtedness of private persons or of incorporated companies on commission or otherwise, shall pay a license of ten dollars (\$10.00) per quarter.

Pawnbrokers shall pay a license of forty dollars (\$40.00) per quarter.

All persons, firms or corporations engaged in a banking business shall pay a license of twenty dollars (\$20.00) per quarter.

That Article 12 of said Section be amended as follows:

Article 12. Every person, firm or corporation manufacturing or selling soft drinks of any kind or description shall pay a

quarterly license of five dollars (\$5.00), except such persons, firms or corporations having a general merchandise license.

That Article 14 of said Section be amended as follows:

Each proprietor of a billiard or pool room shall pay a license of five dollars (\$5.00) per quarter; bowling alleys shall pay a license of six dollars (\$6.00) per quarter and for each alley over two (2) three dollars (\$3.00) per quarter.

That Article 15 of said Section be amended as follows:

Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of photography within the Town of Jerome shall pay a license tax of twelve dollars (\$12.00) annually in advance. Travelling photographers, sixty dollars (\$60.00) in advance.

That Article 17 of said Section be amended as follows:

Article 17. Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of bakery shall pay a license of five dollars (\$5.00) per quarter.

That Article 18 of said Section be amended as follows:

Article 18. Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of job printing shall pay a license of two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) per quarter.

That Article 20 of said Section be amended as follows:

Article 20. Every person firm or corporation engaged in the business of vending ice shall pay a license of five dollars (\$5.00) per quarter.

That Article 24 of said Section be amended as follows:

Article 24. Any person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of livery stables or transfer companies, seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per quarter.

That Article 27 of said section be amended as follows:

Any person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of tailoring or cleaning shall pay a license of seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per quarter.

That Article 30 of said Section be amended as follows:

Article 30. Butcher shops shall pay a license of fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per quarter.

That Article 32 of said Section be amended as follows:

Article 32. Dealers in wood and coal shall pay a license of five dollars (\$5.00) per quarter.

That Article 33 of said Section be amended as follows:

Article 33. Barbershops shall pay a license of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per quarter for each chair.

That Article 34 of said Section be amended as follows:

Article 34. Boot and shoe repair shops shall pay a license of two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) per quarter.

That Article 36 of said Section be amended as follows:
Article 36. Plumbers shall pay a license of five dollars
(\$5.00) per quarter.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in con-
flict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Whereas this ordinance requiring early oper-
ation to preserve the public peace, health and safety, an emergency
is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, adoption and approval by the
Mayor and is hereby exempted from the operation of referendum
provisions of the State Constitution and the Laws of Arizona.
