

ORDINANCE NO. 175

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE ADDITION TO THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, MINORS IN PLACES SERVING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, PROVIDING PENALITIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Section 10-1-25 Minors in Places Serving Alcoholic Beverages.

No person under the age of 19 years shall be admitted after 8:00 o'clock p.m. or be permitted to remain in any saloon, bar room or place of entertainment where any spiritous liquors, wines or malt or intoxicating liquors are sold, exchanged or given away, with the exception of restaurants or places of business whose gross receipts on a daily basis from the sale of food exceed the gross receipts on a daily basis from sale of spiritous liquors, wines or malt or intoxicating liquors. It is unlawful for any parent or guardian to permit any such person to remain in any such saloon, bar room or place of entertainment, and it is unlawful for any minor under the age of 19 years to be found in such place.

Whereas the immediate operation of the provisions of this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Jerome an EMERGENCY is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Jerome and it is hereby exempt from the referendum provisions of the Constitution and Laws of the State of Arizona.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, this 9th day of November, 1976.
