
ORDINANCE NO. 184

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-4-1 - REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE TOWN CODE OF JEROME, ARIZONA, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 2-4-1 amended to read: "The council shall hold regular meetings on the second Tuesday of each month at SEVEN O'CLOCK P.M., provided that when the day fixed for any regular meeting of the council falls upon a day designated by law as legal holiday, such meeting shall be held at the same hour on the next succeeding day not a holiday. All regular meetings of the council shall be held in the Town Hall of Jerome.

Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, that this ordinance become effective immediately, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.


