

ORDINANCE NO. 186

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRANSACTION PRIVILEGE TAX OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, BY EXEMPTING GROCERIES SOLD AT RETAIL BY AMENDING SECTION 8-2-3(A)(11) BY DELETING A PORTION OF SAID PARAGRAPH 11, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA:

Section 1: That Section 8-2-3 (A)(11) of the Code of the Town of Jerome, Arizona is amended, effective October 1, 1980, by deleting therefrom the following:

- 11. Selling at retail such property used by human beings for food, drink or condiment, whether simple, mixed or compounded, where such property is not customarily sold for consumption on the premises commonly and generally known as the business of selling groceries at retail.


Section 2: Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become operative and in force from and after the date of October 1, 1980.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, this 9th day of September, 1980.
