

ORDINANCE NO. 199

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, BY AMENDING SECTION 3-1-1, BY SETTING A TWO YEAR TERM FOR THE OFFICE OF TOWN MAGISTRATE AND PROVIDING FOR REMOVAL OF THE MAGISTRATE ONLY FOR CAUSE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 3-1-1 is amended to read as follows:

Section 3-1-1 OFFICERS.

A. There are hereby created the offices of Town Manager, Town Clerk, Town Marshall, and Town Attorney, who shall be appointed by the Council, and who shall serve at the pleasure of the Council.

B. There is hereby created the office of Town Magistrate, who shall be appointed by the Council. The Magistrate shall serve for a term of two years with the beginning and end of the term to be specified at the time of appointment. During such term, a Magistrate may be removed only for cause.

Section 2: EMERGENCY


Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the Town of Jerome that this ordinance become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
