ORDINANCE 205

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-3-2 (A)&(C) OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, TO CHARGE A FEE OF \$3.00 FOR DOG LICENSES, AND CHANGE THE CALENDAR SCHEDULE FOR ISSUING DOG LICENSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, that:

Section 1.


SECTION 6-3-2 is amended as follows:

- A. All dogs kept, harbored, or maintained, in the Town of Jerome, must be licensed and registered if over four months of age. Dog licenses shall be issued by the poundmaster upon payment of a license fee of three dollars.
- C. It is the duty of such owner to cause to be attached securely around the dog's neck, the metal license tag and said tag shall be kept there at all times whenever the dog is outside the owner's residence during the license period. Dog licenses shall be issued for a period of one year and shall run from the first day of February in each calendar year to the following February 1st.


Section 2. EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, an EMERGENCY is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage and adoption by the Council.


