ORDINANCE NO. 206

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 (ADMINISTRATION), ARTICLE 3-3, SECTION 3-3-8 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA:

That Section 3-3-8 of Article 3-3, Chapter 3 of the Code of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, is amended as follows:

Section 3-3-8


Expenditures under twenty dollars may be made from a petty cash fund and supported by receipts. The purchasing officer may establish such petty cash fund in an amount he deems necessary, but not to exceed two hundred dollars, without the approval of the town council.

WHEREAS, the immediate operation of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, an EMERGENCY is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage and adoption by the Council.


PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, this 27th day of MARCH, 1986.
