ORDINANCE NO. 209

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA  
RENAMING FIRST STREET AND SECOND STREET, AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND (COMMON) COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF  
JEROME, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.: That First Street and Second Street,  
streets within the municipality of the Town of Jerome, running  
parallel to Conglomerate Street, as shown on Map 401, Book 6,  
Page 2, Yavapai County Recorder's Office, shall be renamed as  
follows:

First Street shall be renamed First Avenue.  
Second Street shall be renamed Second Avenue.

Section 2.: Whereas, it is necessary for the preserva-  
tion of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Jerome, Ari-  
zona, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall  
become immediately operative and in force from and after the date  
of posting hereof.
