## ORDINANCE NUMBER 218

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, FINALLY DETERMINING AND ADOPTING ESTIMATES OF PROPOSED EXPENDITURES BY THE TOWN OF JEROME FOR FISCAL YEAR 1988-89 AND DECLARING THAT SUCH SHALL CONSTITUTE A BUDGET OF THE TOWN OF JEROME FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Arizona and ordinances of the Town of Jerome, the Town Council did, on the Twelfth day of July, 1988, make an estimate of the amounts necessary to meet public expenses for Fiscal Year 1988-89; and

WHEREAS, due notice has been given by the Town Clerk, as required by law, that said tentative budget is on file and open to inspection by anyone interested; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on said tentative budget, as required by law:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, YAVAFAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: THAT, the Town Council has finally determined that the estimates of the amounts necessary to meet public expenses for the Fiscal Year 1988-89 for the various purposes therein contained and set forth for the conduct of business of the Town government of the Town of Jerome for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 1988, and ending June 30, 1989. That said estimates of amounts were set forth in that certain document wherein Town Council of the Town of Jerome did, on the Twelfth day of July, 1988, make an estimate of the amounts necessary to meet public expenses for Fiscal Year 1988-89, which said document is on file with the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Jerome, Arizona. That said document was made a public record by Resolution No. 229 of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, and is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as fully set forth in this Ordinance as the official annual budget of the Town of Jerome for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 1988, and ending June 30, 1989, with the following changes:

<u>Section 2:</u> THAT, upon recommendation by the Mayor and with approval of the Town Council, expenditures may be made from the appropriations for contingencies.

<u>Section 3:</u> WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately effective and in force from and after the date of posting hereof.
