

ORDINANCE NO. 220

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF WARRANTS PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF A.R.S. SEC. 11-631 THROUGH 11-640 AND 9-247 THROUGH 249.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA:


Section 1: Issuance of Warrants

That whenever the Town of Jerome is indebted upon an account, due to expenses incurred only for special projects or grant expenditures wherein the money is reimbursed to the town, upon approval for payment of such indebtedness by the Common Council of the Town of Jerome by motion noted in the minutes of a regular or special meeting, the Mayor or Vice-Mayor, in case of the absence or unavailability of the mayor, is authorized to issue warrants upon the Town treasurer for the amount due. Not more than one warrant shall be drawn for the amount allowed. The warrant shall be drawn in favor of the person to whom it is due, and the warrant shall contain at least but not limited to the following information:

Date of Issue, Warrant No., Payee, Amount Due, Payment Due Date, Interest Rate, and Purpose For Which It Is Drawn

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, this 10th day of January, 1989.

APPROVED this 10th day of January, 1989, by the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Common Council of the Town of Jerome, Arizona.




