

ORDINANCE 222

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 189 TO ABOLISH THE POSITION OF TOWN MANAGER AND DELETING ALL REFERENCES TO THE POSITION OF TOWN MANAGER FROM SECTION 3-1-1 AND ANY OTHER SUCH REFERENCES WITHIN THE TOWN CODE AND BY DELETING ENTIRELY SECTION 3-2-5 AND REASSIGNING THOSE DUTIES OUTLINED IN SECTION 3-2-5 OF THE TOWN CODE OF JEROME, ARIZONA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA:

The Town Code of the Town of Jerome is hereby amended by deleting all references to the position of Town Manager from Section 3-1-1 and by deleting Section 3-2-5 entirely and reassigning those duties outlined in Section 3-2-5 as follows:

Items A, Administrative Duties; C, Budget; E, Revenue; F, Inventory; I, Reports; J, Public Contact; K, Office Hours; M, Keys, are hereby reassigned to Clerk.


Items B, Personnel; D, Contracts & Purchasing; G, Real Estate; L, Maintenance, are hereby reassigned to Council.

Item H is reassigned to Clerk and revised to read as follows:
"The town Clerk shall attend meetings of the town council as required or necessary. The town clerk may represent the town at meetings of other government agencies, conferences, organizations, and clubs and speak on behalf of the town at these meetings as requested by the council."

Item N is hereby deleted entirely.


PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, this 10th day of January, 1989.

APPROVED this 10th day of January, 1989, by the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the Common Council of the Town of Jerome, Arizona.


