

ORDINANCE NO. 225

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA AMENDING SECTION 6-3-2 (A) & (C) OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA TO CHARGE A FEE OF \$5 FOR DOG LICENSES, AND CHANGE THE CALENDAR SCHEDULE FOR ISSUING DOG LICENSES


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA:

Section 6-3-2 is amended as follows:


A. All dogs kept, harbored, or maintained, in the Town of Jerome must be licensed and registered if over four months of age. Dog licenses shall be issued by the Town Clerk upon payment of license fee of five dollars.


C. It is the duty of such owner to cause to be attached securely around the dog's neck, the metal license tag and said tag shall be kept there at all times whenever the dog is outside the owner's residence during the license period. Dog licenses shall be issued for a period of one year and shall run from the first day of January in each calendar year to the following January first.
