

ORDINANCE NO. 226

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, ESTABLISHING A PARKING DEVELOPMENT FUND TO BE USED FOR ACQUISITION AND CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONAL PARKING AREAS AND/OR UPGRADING AND MAINTENANCE OF PRESENT PARKING AREAS.

WHEREAS, it has been found necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Town of Jerome that more parking should be provided, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is empowered to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the Town of Jerome; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Town of Jerome to provide the necessary parking a special Parking Fund is hereby established;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

Certain fees shall be imposed upon property owners in the commercial district from time to time to meet the needs of providing adequate parking for the commercial district.

Said fees shall be held by the Town in a special Parking Fund to be used solely for the acquisition and construction of additional parking areas and/or upgrading and maintenance of present parking areas. Said fee shall be paid in full prior to the issuance of a building permit.



APPROVED this 8th day of August, 1989, by the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the Common Council of the Town of Jerome, Arizona.




