

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE TOWN OF JEROME, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ADOPTING THE UNIFORM
CODE FOR THE ABATEMENT OF
DANGEROUS BUILDINGS BY REFERENCE

WHEREAS, there are many structures in Jerome which constitute public safety and health hazards and the safety of Jerome citizens is paramount;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: THAT, certain document known as "Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings", 1988 Edition, is hereby adopted by reference and three (3) copies of the same shall be on file in the office of the Town Clerk for the Town of Jerome, Arizona, for public inspection and use.

Section 2: Said code shall be codified into the Town Code of Jerome in Chapter 7-5 and shall read as follows:

Article 7-5:

That certain code entitled "Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings", 1988 Edition, copy-righted by the International Conference of Building Officials, is hereby adopted as the "Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings of the Town of Jerome", and made a part of this chapter the same as though said code was specifically set forth in full herein.
