

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 25

REGULATING THE STORAGE OF POWDER AND OTHER EXPLOSIVES

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any perons or persons to store or cause to be stored, keep or cause to be kept within the town limits, any gunpowder, blasting powder, powder, Nitro-glycerine, coal oil or any other explosive or combustibile material of like nature, except upon the permission of the Common Council and then in amount not to exceed fifty pounds of black powder and two hundred gallons of coal oil, to be kept for immediate use or sale.

Section 2. Any person or persons violatng any of the provisions of this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a not to exceed \$100.00 and in case said fine is not paid, the person or persons convicted shall be imprisoned in the town jail until said fine is satisfied, at the rate of one days imprisonment for each dollar of said fine.

Section 3. This ordinance to be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
