

ORDINANCE NO. 270

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 170 THE TOWN CODE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME BY PROVIDING A REGULATION DISQUALIFYING COUNCILMEMBERS FROM SERVING ON TOWN COMMITTEES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA:

Section 2-4-7 Committees and Commissions is hereby amended to read:

The council may create such committees and commissions, standing or special, as it deems necessary, they shall consist of as many members and shall perform such duties as the council may require and shall exist at the pleasure of the council. Persons elected to Town Council, upon being seated, shall no longer be qualified to serve on Town committees, including, but not limited to, Design Review, Planning and Zoning, Board of Adjustment, unless otherwise provided by law.


