ORDINANCE NO. 304

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, RELATING TO THE PRIVILEGE LICENSE TAX; ADOPTING "THE 1999 AMENDMENTS TO THE TAX CODE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME" BY REFERENCE: ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA:

Section 1: That certain document known as the "1999 Amendments to the Tax Code of the Town of Jerome," three copies of which are on file in the office of the town clerk of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution 358 of the Town of Jerome, Arizona is hereby referred to, adopted and made part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

Section 2: Except as provided in Sections 3 and 4 of this ordinance, the provisions of this ordinance and the public record adopted herein are effective from and after December 31, 1999

Section 3: The following provisions of the public record adopted herein are retroactive to January 1, 1999:

- (a) Subsection (b) (3) of section 8A-415.
- (b) Subsection (c) (1) (A) of section 8A-416.
- (c) Subsection (b) (1) (A) of section 8A-417


Section 4: The following provisions of the public record adopted herein are retroactive to May 5, 1999:

- (a) Subsection (c) (10) of section 8A-450.
- (b) Subsection (kk) of section 8A-465.

Section 5: Any person found guilty of violating any provision of these amendments to the tax code shall be guilty of a class one misdemeanor. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offense punishable as herein above described.

Section 6: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phase or portion of this ordinance or any part of these amendments to the tax code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
