

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 38

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING IN FULL THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCES HERETOFORE PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA.

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following ordinances heretofore passed by the Common Council of the Town of Jerome, and respectively numbered: 3,4,7,8, 10,11, and amendments thereto 12,15,17,19,20,21,22,23,24,26,27,28,29,30,31,32,33,34,35, and an ordinance entitled: "Regulating the use of Main Street," said ordinance not being numbered in the book of ordinances, but appearing upon page 107 of said book of ordinances, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force or effect from and after its passage.
