AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE# 1, ENTITLED, "OFFICERS AND THEIR DUTIES", AND ORDINANCE " 2, ENTITLED, "RELATING TO MISDEMEANORS IN GENERAL."

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 1 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: that the following officers in and for the Town of Jerome, are hereby created: Clerk, Treasurer, Marshall, Deputy Marshall, Collector of Taxes, Assessor, Attorney, Health Officer, Supervisor of Streets and Chief and Assistant Chief of the Fire Department.

Section 2. That section 2 of Ordinance 1, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows, The Clerk shall be Fx-Officio Treasurer and Assessor. The Marshall shall be Fx-Officio Collector of Taxes and they shall with the Supervisor of Streets be elected in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. That section 3 of ordinance 1 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: The Justice of the Peace, elected in and for the Jerome precinct, shall, when duly qualified, have jurisdiction to hear and determine all criminal prosecutions, and civil suits for the violation of all Ordinances of the Town of Jerome, and shall exclusive jurisdiction to hear and determine any action, subject to the right of appeal as provided by the statutes of the Territory of Arizona. All proceedings in violation of the Town Ordinances shall be commenced and prosecuted in the name of the Mayor and Town Councilof the town of Jerome. All monies received from the payment of fines, shall, after the costs of prosecution have been deducted be paid to the Treasurer of the Town by the Justice collecting the same.

Section 5. That section 21 of Ordinance 2, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: if any person within corportate limits of the Town of Jerome shall carry concealed or otherwise, or have on or about his person, any pistol or other firearm, dirk, dagger, sling shot, sword, cane, spear, brass knuckles of metal, a bowie knife, or any kind of knife, or weapon, except a pocket knife, not manufactured the use of offence and defence, shall be guilty of a misdemeamor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than twenty nor more than three hundred dollars, and shall be imprise oned in the town or County Jail for not less than ten nor more than thirty days, provided this section shall not be construed to apply to Sheriffs, Marshalls, Constable, or any police officers, when exercising their legitimate duties.

Section 6. That section 22 of Ordinance 2, be and is hereby repealed.

Section 7. That section 2h of Ordinance 2, be and the same is herby amended to read as follows: "that it shall be unlawful for any infant or minor under the age of sixteen years to loiter about any saloon in the Town of Jerome and it shall be unlawful for any such infant or minor, under the age of sixteen years to loiter about the streets, alleys or any public place in said Town of Jerome or to be found about said Town after the hour of eight o'clock, p.m., unless such minor shall be upon some legitimate errand, sent by the parent or guardial of said minor."

Section 8. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinare hereby repealed.

Section 9. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and posting as required by law.
