

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 50

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons who is the the owner of any dog, male or female, to allow his or her dog to run at large in the town of Jerome without having paid a tax as specified in this ordinance. Any person or persons who shall allow a dog to run at large without having paid a tax to the Marshall of said town, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in the sum of not less than five dollars and no more than fifty dollars.

Section 2. Any person or persons who shall let run at large within the said Town of Jerome shall pay to the said Marshall of said town, the sum of three dollars per annum for each male dog and the sum of five dollars per annum for each female dog and it shall be the duty of the Marshall to issue a license to such owner or keeper with a tag bearing the license number which tag shall by the owner or keeper be attached to and worn on a collar around the neck of such dog.

The Marshall shall keep a record of such license and said tax when so collected shall be paid over by him to the Treasurer of the said Town of Jerome to be placed to the current expense fund of the town.

The Marshal, Deputy Marshall or any person appointed by the Marshall of the said Town is hereby authorized to kill and remove any dog, male or female, found running at large within the limits of the Town of Jerome; and any dog, male or female shall be considered running at large unless licensed and tagged as provided for in this ordinance. Any such dog, male or female, not so marked and licensed may be killed by any of the persons above mentioned and authorized when found running at large in violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. The Council shall allow the Marshall or other proper officer the sum of fifty cents for each dog he may kill under the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
