

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 64

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING RIDING AND DRIVING UPON THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Every person riding, driving or propelling or in charge of any vehicle upon any of the streets within the Town of Jerome, shall ride, drive or propel such vehicle upon such street in a careful manner with due regard to safety and convenience of pedestrians and all other vehicles upon said streets.

Section 2. Every person riding, driving or propeling or in charge of any vehicle upon any of the streets of the Town of Jerome shall turn to the right and on all occasions when it is practical so to do shall travel on the right side of said streets, and as near the right hand curb as is practical.

Section 3. Every person riding, driving, propelling or in charge of any vehicle shall in overtaking any other vehicle upon any street within the Town of Jerome shall, before turning, stopping or changing the course of such vehicle, first see that there is sufficient space so that such movement can be made in safety.

Section 5. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride, drive or propel any motor vehicle or any vehicle on any of the streets of the Town of Jerome at a rate of speed greater than ten miles per hour.

Section 6. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride any bicycle, motor vehicle or run or drive any automobile upon any of the streets of the Town of Jerome after sunset or before sunrise without carrying upon the front of such bicycle, motor vehicle or automobile a good, lighted lamp or lantern, and upon the rear of such vehicle a red light. Such automovile shall at all times carry a horn and such bicycle or motor vehicle a bell or horn, which said bell or horn shall be sounded by persons operating said automobiles, bicycles, or motor vehicles when turning from one street into another or for the purpose of giving warning only, and any other use of same shall be deemed a nuisance. No person shall ride a bicycle or motor vehicle upon any of the sidewalks of the Town of Jerome.

Section 7. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride drive or propel any motor vehicle on any of the streets of the Town of Jerome without using, applying and having it in operation a muffler to deaden the sound made by said motor vehicle.

Section 8. The word "street", wherever herein used shall be taken to mean any street, avenue, alley or driveway within the Town of Jerome, and the Words "motor vehicle" shall include all vehicles propelled by any power other than muscular power.

Section 9. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, (\$100.00) or by a fine not exceeding thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment for the sfirst offense; and punishable by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) , or imprisonment for a time not

exceeding thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment for the second offense; and punishable by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars(\$100.00) nor more than one hundred and ninety nine dollars (\$199.00) or imprisonment exceeding thirty days (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment for the third and subsequent offense.

Section 10. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 11. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and posting and publication as required by law.
