TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 73

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF HOLDING STATED MEETINGS OF THE COMMON COUNCIL AND PROVIDING FOR CALLING SPECIAL MEETINGS THERFOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE STOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA.

Section 1. The Common Council shall hold a stated meeting on the second Tuesday of each month, at the hour of eight oclock p.m. at the town hall.

Section 2. The Mayor may convene the Common Council at any time for a special meeting, other than the time stated in Section 1, hereof, by causeing personal notice to be give to the members of the Council by the Town Marshall.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section h_{\bullet} . This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and posting.
