

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 78

RELATING TO THE TAX LEVY FOR THE YEAR 1917.

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the assessment roll as assigned by the Tax Assessor of the town of Jerome, for the year 1917, and equalized by the Board of Equalization, amounting in all to \$1,653,398.58, be and the same is hereby accepted as the total assessable property within the corporate limits of the Town of Jerome.

Section 2. The tax levy for the year 1917, shall be \$1.5301 on each One Hundred dollars of assessable property within the corporate limits of the Town of Jerome, to be apportioned as follows, to-wit: four mills on the dollar, amounting to the sum of \$6613.594, to be paid to the Salary, Ordinary and Contingent Fund.

Seven and 0/10 mills on the dollar, amounting to \$6613.594, to be paid to the street and general improvement fund.

Section 3. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to draw a warrant upon the Tax Collector for the collection of the amount of taxes as levied, and the same shall be due and payable on and after October 15th, 1917, and shall become delinquent on November 15th, 1917.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect after its passage and posting as required by law.
