

TOWN ORDINANCE 81

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LOITERING, PICKETING, CARRYING OR DISPLAYING BANNERS, BADGES, SIGNS OR TRANSPARENCIES, OR SPEAKING IN PUBLIC STREETS, SIDEWALKS, ALLEYS, OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACES IN A LOUD OR UNUSUAL TONE, FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES THEREIN NAMED, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY OF ANY VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person in and upon any public street, sidewalk, alley or other public place in the Town of Jerome, to make any loud or unusual noise, or to speak in a loud or unusual tone, or to cry out or proclaim, for the purpose of inducing or influencing, or attempting to induce or influence, any persons to refrain from entering any works or factory or any place of business or employment, or for the purpose of inducing or influencing or attempting to induce or influence any person to refrain from purchasing or using any goods, wares, merchandise or other article or articles, or for the purpose of inducing or influencing or attempting to induce or influence any person to refrain from doing or performing any service or labor in any works, factory, place of business, or employment or for the purpose of intimidating, threatening or coercing, or attempting to intimidate, threaten or coerce, any person who is performing, seeking to perform, or obtaining service or labor in any works, factory, place of business or employment.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, in or upon any public street, sidewalk, alley or other public place in the Town of Jerome, to loiter in front of or in the vicinity of, or to carry, show or display any banner, transparency badge or sign in front of, or in the vicinity of any works, or factory, or any place of business or employment, for the purpose of inducing or influencing or attempting to induce or influence, any person to refrain from entering any such works or factory or place of business, or employment, or for the purpose of inducing or influencing or attempting to induce or influence, any person to refrain from purchasing or using any goods, wares, merchandise, or other articles, manufactured, kept or made for sale therein, or for the purpose of inducing or influencing or attempting to induce or influence, any person to refrain from doing or performing any service or labor in any works, factory, place of business or employment, or for the purpose of intimidating, threatening or coercing or attempting to intimidate, threaten, or coerce any person who is performing, seeking or obtaining service or labor in any such works, factory, place of business or employment.

Section 3. That any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars and not less than twenty-five dollars, or by imprisonment in the Town Jail of not more than fifty days nor less than twelve days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary to the welfare of the Town, and requires immediate operation to preserve the public safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and posting or publication, and the same is hereby exempted from the operation of the referendum provisions of the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Arizona.

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 83

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF TOWN ENGINEER, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT THEREOF, AND FIXING THE SALARY OF SUCH OFFICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby created the office of Town Engineer. The Town Engineer shall be appointed by the Common Council, and shall hold office until removed by that body.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of such officer to establish for the Town of Jerome, a datum plane, which plane when established shall be marked as a monument to be placed at such a point as he shall think best within said Town, and all grades pertaining to said Town of Jerome shall be established with reference to said datum plane; the Town Engineer shall under the direction of the Common Council, make such surveys as may be necessary for said Town, and establish grades for streets and sidewalks in such a manner as the Common Council may direct; file copies of all surveys, maps, plats and estimates made by him for said town with the Town Clerk, and perform all such further duties as the Common Council may require of him.

Section 3. The compensation of the Town Engineer shall be such as the Common Council by resolution may provide.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and become operative thirty days after its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
