

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 89

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Any person, firm, association or corporation within the Town of Jerome, licensed by said Town to carry on any business, who shall conduct or permit to be carried on, any unlawful act or business within such place so licensed, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction immediately forfeit the license issued by the said Town of Jerome.

Section 2. No person, firm, association or corporation conducting any pool or billiard hall or place, where soft drinks are sold or cards or other games of chance played, shall have any window to such place curtained or painted more than one-half way from the bottom to the top, nor conduct any such business or any unlawful business in any such place, where the door or doors leading into such place are locked or otherwise fastened.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction, be fined in any sum of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than two hundred dollars, and be imprisoned in the Town Jail not less than ten days nor more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and posting required by law.
