

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 90

PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A DEPUTY TOWN MARSHALL.

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There shall be and there is hereby appointed by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Jerome, a Deputy Town Marshall, who shall hold office during the pleasure of said Mayor and Common Council, and whose duties shall be to enforce the ordinance of said Town, under the direction of said Mayor and Common Council.

Section 2. The said Deputy Town Marshall shall receive a salary of one hundred and fifty dollars per month.

Section 3. The said Deputy Town Marshall shall not act as a Deputy Tax or License Collector of said Town of Jerome.

INASMUCH as the appointment of a Deputy Town Marshall is necessary, and requires an immediate appointment to preserve the public peace and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and posting, and the same is hereby exempted from the operation of the referendum provisions of the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Arizona.

PASSED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, UPON THE 15th DAY OF DECEMBER 1917, BY THE FOLLOWING VOTE: AYES-3, NAYS-1.
