

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 93

RELATING TO GAMBLING.

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Every person who shall deal, carry on, or open or cause to be opened, or who shall conduct, either as owner, proprietor or employee, whether for hire or not, any game of faro, twenty-one, poker, monte, roulette, lasquet, rouge et noir, rondo, vingt-un or stud poker, draw poker, bluff, fan tan, thaw, seven and one-half, chuck-a-luck, black jack, or any other similar game whatsoever, played with cards, dice or other device, and every slot machine or machine of like character whether the same be played for money, checks, credits or other representative thing of value, within the corporate limits of the Town of Jerome, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars nor more than three hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the Town Jail for not more than three months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

INASMUCH as this ordinance is necessary to meet an existing condition, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and posting, and the same is hereby exempted from the referendum provisions of the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Arizona.
