

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 97

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING CONNECTION WITH THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR ITS VIOLATION.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Jerome, as follows:

Section 1. All persons owning or occupying any premises within the corporate limits of the Town of Jerome, and having or using thereon any water closet, cesspool, toilet, bath or sink, are hereby required to connect the same within sixty days from the taking effect of this Ordinance, to the public sewer system of the Town of Jerome.

Section 2. All water closets and cesspools within said corporate limits of the said city not connected with the said public sewer system are hereby declared a nuisance and any person owning or using the same is hereby required to fill or remove the same within the period of ten days from the taking effect of this ordinance.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five (25) dollars, nor more than three hundred (300) dollars, or by imprisonment in the city jail for not exceeding three months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and adoption by the Common Council, and approval by the Mayor and posting and publication as required by law.
