

TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 99

THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JEROME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Any person, firm or corporation owning or operating any Hotel or Rooming House, catering to transient trade, within the corporate limits of the Town of Jerome, is hereby required to procure and keep a Register, showing the name of all persons receiving accommodations at such hotel or rooming house, date of arrival and leaving thereof.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined in any sum of not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, or be imprisoned in the Town jail for not less than five days nor more than thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval as now provided by law.
