ORDINANCE NO. 361

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME, ARIZONA, RELATING TO THE PRIVILEGE LICENSE TAX: AMENDING THE TAX CODE OF THE TOWN OF JEROME. ARTICLE IV PRIVILEGE TAXES, SECTION 8A-460 (a), BY INCREASING THE GENERAL RATE OF TAXATION FROM THREE PERCENT (3.0 %) TO THREE AND ONE HALF PERCENT (3.5%); PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; DESIGNATING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND MAKING PROVISION FOR EXISTING CONTRACTS.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Jerome, Arizona, as follows:

Section I. Tax Rate Increase

The tax rate set forth in each of the following sections of the Town Tax Code is increased from three percent (3.0%) to three and one half percent (3.5%).

Advertising
Amusements, exhibitions, and similar activities
Job printing
Manufactured buildings
Timbering and other extraction
Publishing and periodicals distribution
Hotels
Rental, leasing, and licensing for use of real property
Rental, leasing, and licensing for use of tangible personal property
Restaurants and bars
Retail sales: measure of tax; burden of proof; exclusions
Telecommunication services
Transporting for hire
Utility services

Section II. Violations and Penalties

Any person found guilty of violating any provision of these amendments to the Tax Code shall be guilty of a class one misdemeanor. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offence punishable as herein above described.

Section III. Providing for Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference, are hereby repealed.

Section III. Providing for Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.





Section IV. Making Provision for Existing Contracts.

The tax imposed pursuant to Section 1 of this ordinance shall not apply to contracts entered into prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section V. Effective Date.

The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2010,
